FOOD SERVICE

Food Service - All students K-12 will receive free breakfast and lunch this year. Although there is no paperwork to qualify for free meals this year, we are asking every family to fill out the household information report. Please scan the QR code for Meal Magic and go to apply for benefits.





FEVER - Temperature of 100.0 or higher is an indication that your child is ill and likely contagious. Giving a child Tylenol or Motrin will bring their temperature down and make them more comfortable, but will not prevent them from passing their illness on to classmates. Temperature must be normal for 24 hours without medication before they can return to school.

VOMITING & DIARRHEA - Please do not send your child to school if they are vomiting or having 2 or more watery stools in a 24 hour period.





EYES - We understand that eyes are sometimes swollen and irritated by allergens or viruses. Because of the extremely contagious nature of Bacterial Pink Eye, we ask you to consult your docotr before sending your child to school with these symptoms: thick mucus draining from eye, or if the eye is red, puffy, itchy or painful. Your child can attend school 24 hours after starting medical treatment (medication).

RASH - Body rash, especially with fever and/or itching. Students with infectious rashes such as ringworm, impetigo and scabies will be excluded from school until they are under an effective treatment (medication) and no longer considered contagious.



SORE THROAT OR COUGH - Especially with fever, or swollen glands in the neck. A frequent or severe cough can be a distraction to the class. Please do not send cough drops with your child for coughs unless it is also accompanied with written permission by parent and physician.

Head Lice - Children cannot return to school until their hair has been treated with an appropriate lice treatment (either over-the-counter or prescription). They are to be free of live Lice. The student must check in with the school nurse before returning to class.
