Feeding America Donation Drive

Since 2015, our Belding Area School Feeding America site has provided food to over 100 local families every month. This number has recently been increasing. The poverty rate in Ionia County is 11.5% while another 25% of people do not make enough money to provide for their basic needs. In total, over 36% of people in our county need help with basic needs such as food.



Our Feeding America Food Truck program alleviates some of the stress and financial burdens individuals have regarding feeding their families. It allows families in need to receive fresh fruits, vegetables, dairy and baked goods they would not be able to purchase if it were not for this program.

We have been able to sustain this program here through donations and volunteers by community members like you. We are doing our annual No Shave November activities at the schools to raise money for Feeding America Right Now. We would like to give the community a chance to get involved.

If you would also like to donate you can:

If you donate this way, please email me and tell me that you donated and how much your donation was so that we can add it to the Schools total donations for November.
3. Donate at the cash registers at Wesco in Belding.

A Feeding America food truck will be at BHS each month for anyone in the community who is in need. Cars will line up in the lower lot at the high school while volunteers help load from 4:30-5:30 or until the food is gone.

To request a toy, complete the Toy Application for the Toys for Tots Chapter nearest you on their website <https://www.toysfortots.org/>.

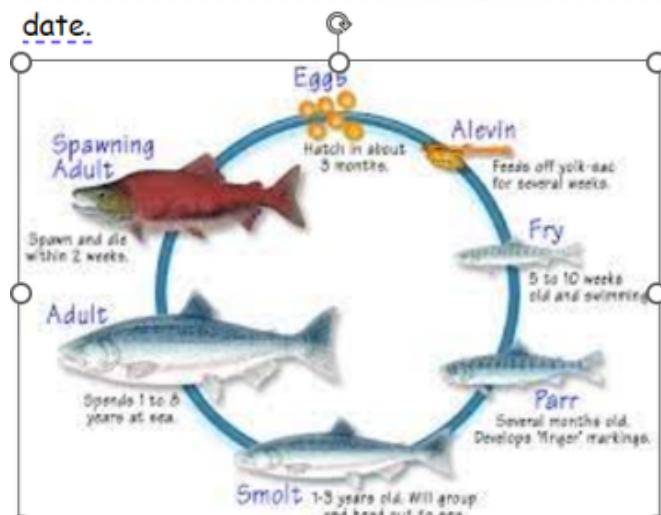
The deadline to request a toy is **December 1st**.

They will watch as the fish hatch in alevin, grow to fry, parr and finally smolt stages. Students will do water quality testing and learn about the impact environmental changes have on the life of the salmon. The salmon will be released in the spring. Woodview After-School Choir

Dear Woodview Parent,

This year Woodview will be re-starting an after school choir, open to all Woodview students. The Woodview Choir will be a club for students interested in furthering their music education. Students will have the opportunity to learn vocal technique, advanced music not offered in class, and develop friendships with other students who share their interests. Participation in choir will prepare them for music ensemble opportunities in middle school.



The choir will be held after school on **Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:45-4:30 pm** in the Woodview music room. The choir will run from January 9th to February 15th. This is several weeks shorter than usual due to the fact I am expecting a baby late February. A small performance will be given at the end of the choir season-February 15th at 4:30. Students will be bussed over to the high school auditorium at the end of the day, so parents/friends just need to arrive at the high school at 4:30 to see the performance. No audition required, just a parent permission slip ask for one from your student's teacher). **Students have until December 1st to sign up.**

Participation in choir will require a level of responsibility from parents and students. Parents will be responsible for picking up their child from rehearsal and communicating any changes in transportation to the music teacher. There will also be a **snack sign up** for one or two parents to bring a snack at each rehearsal. Parent volunteers are encouraged to stay for rehearsal as well!

Students will be held responsible for attendance at rehearsals and practicing their music. If a student misses more than 3 rehearsals, they may not be able to perform, depending on the situation. Students will take music to and from rehearsals in a folder at all rehearsals. Free folders will be available upon request. Choir participation is also contingent upon student behavior in school. The principal and the music teacher both hold the right to remove a student from choir due to their behavior at school. After all, it is a privilege to be a part of the Woodview Choir, and members should be a good example to all students.

The purpose of Choir is to have fun making music! My hope for Woodview Choir is to be a safe place for students to be themselves and discover something that brings them joy.

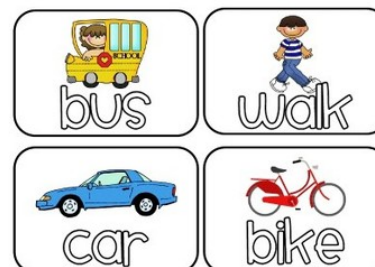

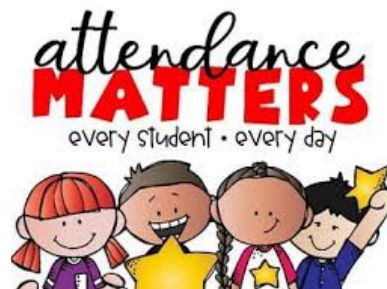
