
TWO SENTENCE SCARY STORY

TOYS FOR TOTS



Dear Woodview Parent,

This year Woodview will be re-starting an after school choir, open to all Woodview students. The Woodview Choir will be a club for students interested in furthering their music education. Students will have the opportunity to learn vocal technique, advanced music not offered in class, and develop friendships with other students who share their interests. Participation in choir will prepare them for music ensemble opportunities in middle school.

The choir will be held after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:45-4:30 pm in the Woodview music room. The choir will run from January 9th to February 15th. This is several weeks shorter than usual due to the fact I am expecting a baby late February. A small performance will be given at the end of the choir season-February 15th at 4:30. Students will be bussed over to the high school auditorium at the end of the day, so parents/friends just need to arrive at the high school at 4:30 to see the performance. No audition required, just a

parent permission slip ask for one from your student's teacher). Students have until December 1st to sign up.

Participation in choir will require a level of responsibility from parents and students. Parents will be responsible for picking up their child from rehearsal and communicating any changes in transportation to the music teacher. There will also be a snack sign up for one or two parents to bring a snack at each rehearsal. Parent volunteers are encouraged to stay for rehearsal as well!

Students will be held responsible for attendance at rehearsals and practicing their music. If a student misses more than 3 rehearsals, they may not be able to perform, depending on the situation. Students will take music to and from rehearsals in a folder at all rehearsals. Free folders will be available upon request. Choir participation is also contingent upon student behavior in school. The principal and the music teacher both hold the right to remove a student from choir due to their behavior at school. After all, it is a privilege to be a part of the Woodview Choir, and members should be a good example to all students.

The purpose of Choir is to have fun making music! My hope for Woodview Choir is to be a safe place for students to be themselves and discover something that brings them joy.

5TH GRADE POINSETTIAS FUNDRAISER



FEVER - Temperature of 100.0 or higher is an indication that your child is ill and likely contagious. Giving a child Tylenol or Motrin will bring their temperature down and make them more comfortable, but will not prevent them from passing their illness on to classmates. Temperature must be normal for 24 hours without medication before they can return to school.

VOMITING & DIARRHEA - Please do not send your child to school if they are vomiting or having 2 or more watery stools in a 24 hour period.





EYES - We understand that eyes are sometimes swollen and irritated by allergens or viruses. Because of the extremely contagious nature of Bacterial Pink Eye, we ask you to consult your docotr before sending your child to school with these symptoms: thick mucus draining from eye, or if the eye is red, puffy, itchy or painful. Your child can attend school 24 hours after starting medical treatment (medication).

RASH - Body rash, especially with fever and/or itching.Students with infectious rashes such as ringworm, impetigo and scabies will be excluded from school until they are under an effective treatment (medication) and no longer considered contagious.





SORE THROAT OR COUGH - Especially with fever, or swollen glands in the neck. A frequent or severe cough can be a distraction to the class. Please do not send cough drops with your child for coughs unless it is also accompanied with written permission by parent and physician.

Head Lice - Children cannot return to school until their hair has been treated with an appropriate lice treatment (either over-the-counter or prescription). They are to be free of live Lice. The student must check in with the school nurse before returning to class.







Woodview drop off begins at 8:15 a.m. All students are to remain in their drop-off bus or vehicle until 8:15 a.m. No early drop-offs are permitted.


