If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier. These results will provide a more complete picture of what your child knows and is ready to learn—whether it is on, above, or below their grade level.

I am very proud of the growth that each classroom made from Fall to Winter.

We had multiple classrooms that are highly effective in their growth. This stems from the students and teachers hard work in the classroom.



wv-trans@bas-k12.org or email your student's teacher.

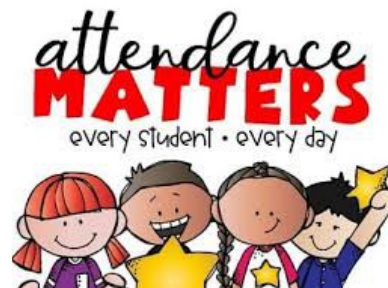
It is still recommended that all request are made before 2:00 p.m. Last minute changes can lead to confusion.
