We are starting the state assessment called M-STEP. This is a computerized test not a paper pencil test. The students will use Chromebooks to take this test. It will cover reading, and math for 3rd and 4th. In Fifth grade, they will take the math, reading, science and social studies test. The test is given in the spring starting in April. The fifth grade will test on April 11, 16, 18 and 23, fourth grade will test April 25 and 30 and third grade will test April 17 and 24.

<u>It is very important that we have your students here on these days well rested (8 hours of sleep)</u>. <u>Please do everything in your power not to make appointments during the testing window.</u>

With the test being computerized, test makeups will be difficult, as other people will be testing during that window.

Everyone attending the summer enrichment classes reports to Ellis Elementary June 10th - July 25th no school the week of July 1st




The Belding High School gymnasium walking track is now open for community use. The track is open, free of charge, to community members.

Anyone wishing to walk on weeknights during school athletic events, is welcome to do so; however, they will be required to purchase a gate ticket for the scheduled event. Seniors 62 years and older may request a free pass through the Athletic Department (794-4950). Valid season passes will also be accepted.

Walking Track: Sunday evenings: 6:00–8:00 pm at the High School. Free to the public. November 5, 2023, through March 31, 2024. For more information contact the Community Education office at 616-794-4646. **Please know that if you bring children with you, they must walk with you. There is no available place for children to play in the gym.**

Please Note:

- All walkers will be required to sign a waiver the first time they walk
- Anyone wishing to walk during times when school is in session must have a background check. Please allow 24 hours to process the background check and bring a photo ID for verification.
- Walkers during the school day must check in with the high school office.
