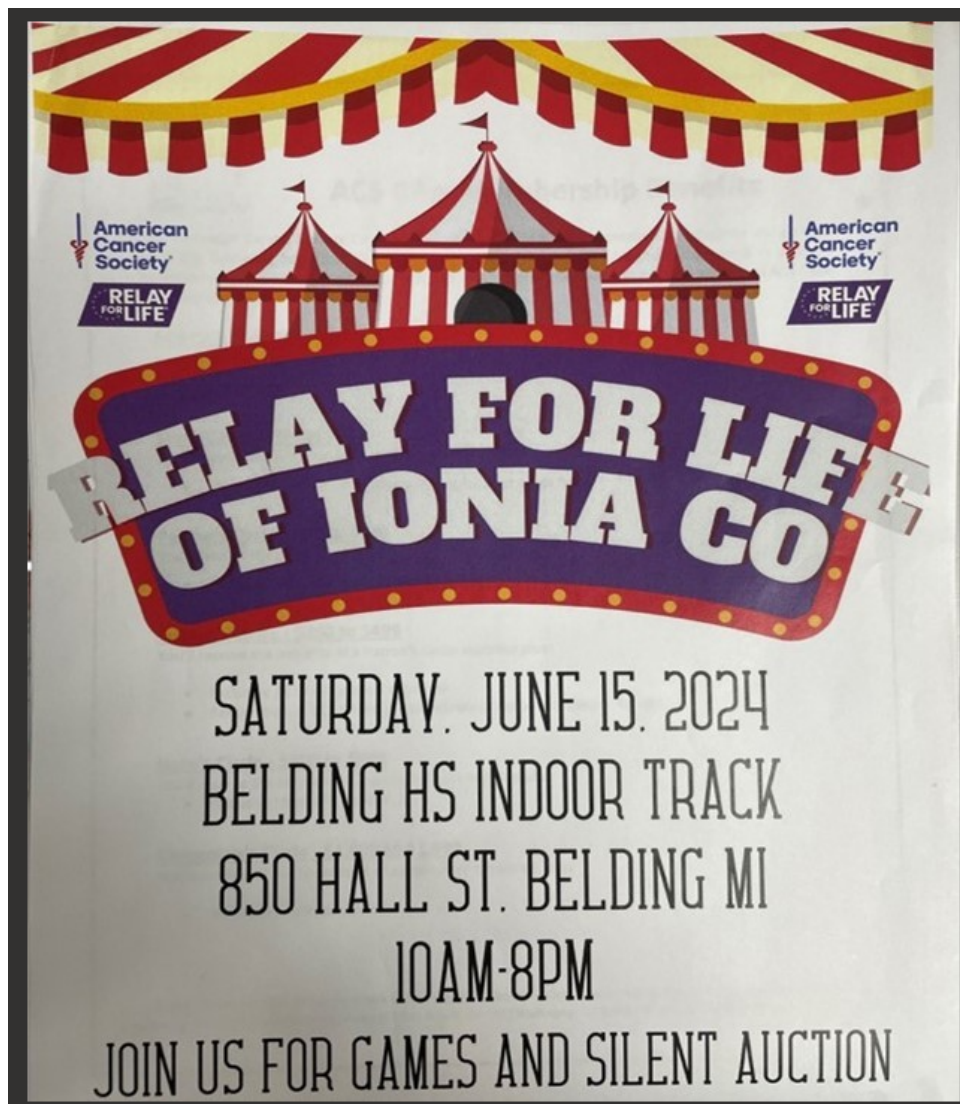

Belding Committee meetings are held the second Tuesday each month starting at 6:30 p.m.

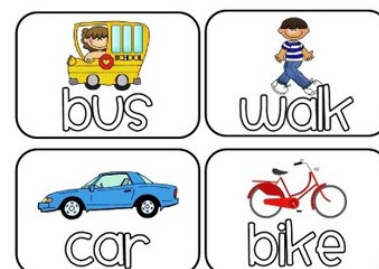
Public attendance is welcomed and encouraged.

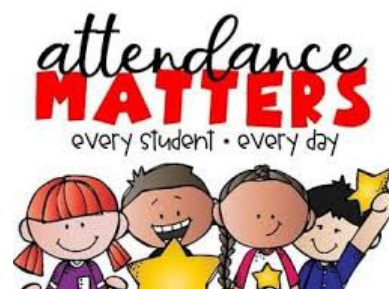
***It is still recommended that all request are made before 2:00 p.m.*** Last minute changes can lead to confusion.
