## MEMORIZE MULTIPLICATION FACTS

It's time for students to memorize multiplication facts – all the way up to their 12 times tables.

Start with the easy ones:

- Any number multiplied by one remains the same.
- Any number multiplied by two is just that number plus itself.
- Any number multiplied by 10 gets a zero on the end.
- Any number up to nine multiplied by 11 is the same digit repeated twice.

Use drill and practice strategies to commit the multiplication tables to memory.



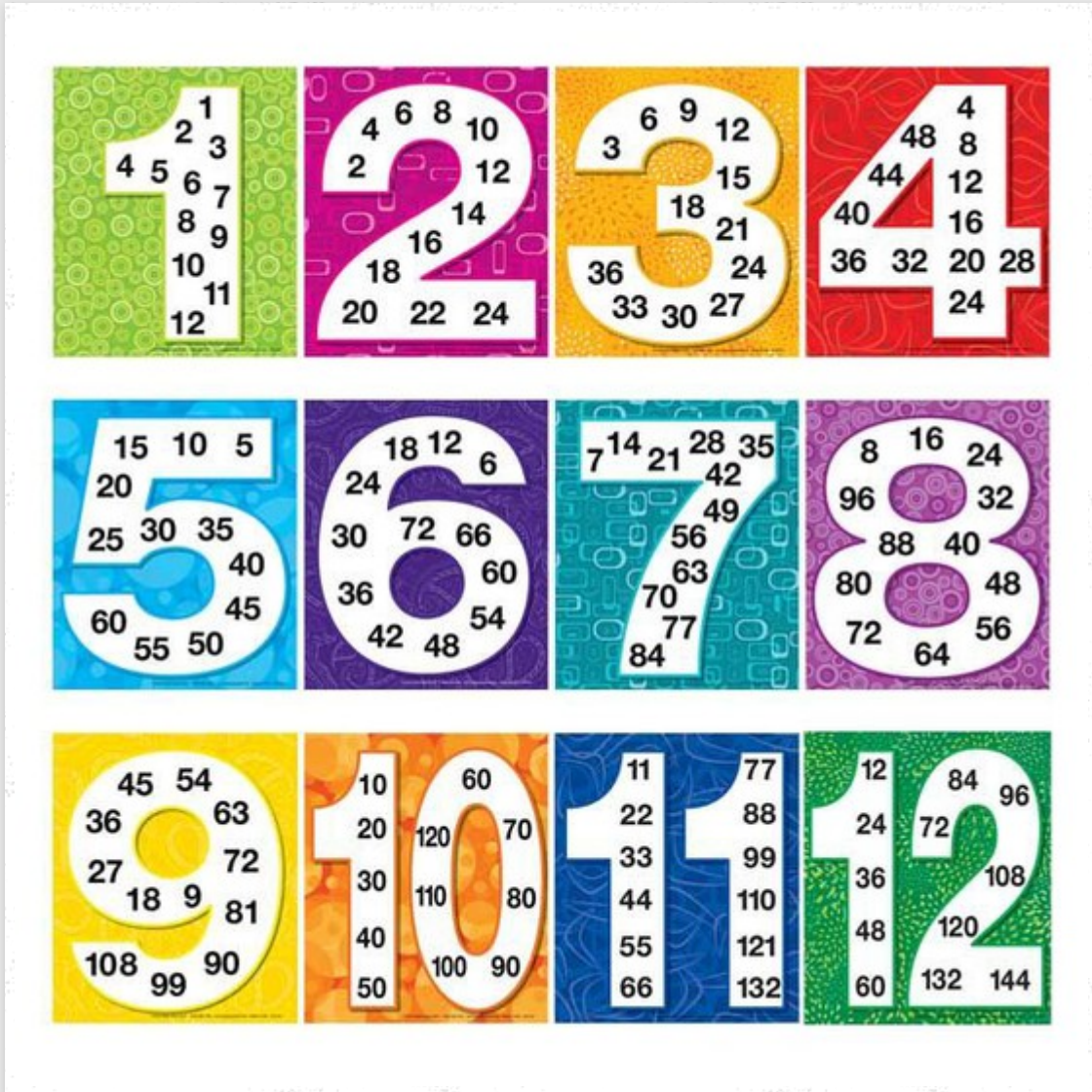

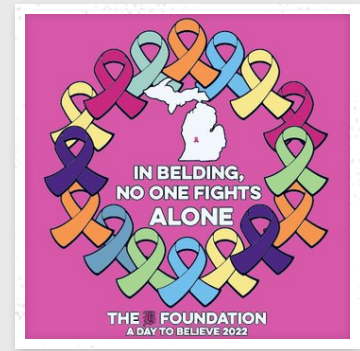
## THE B FOUNDATION DAY TO BELIEVE GLOW RUN/WALK 5K 2023

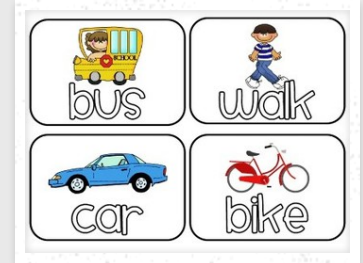

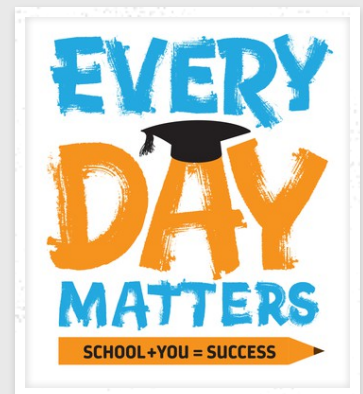
