Parents,

Our students took the NWEA MAP test. This test will help drive our instruction and show student growth. We will be sending home students' scores after each testing session so parent can see the growth. Below is a brief overview of the test.

NWEA Testing Overview

NWEA is an achievement test in Mathematics and Reading that is taken on the computer, with just one question at a time displayed. The test automatically adjusts in difficulty, according to student performance on each question answered. This way each test is individualized for each student. Woodview students participate in NWEA Math and Reading testing three times a year: fall, winter and spring. Students set goals for performance growth following each testing session. They can also compare their scores to those of thousands of other students in the nation.

Teachers can analyze test scores in order to...

- plan instruction
- plan collaboration
- set growth targets for students
- monitor student progress
- assess student strengths and weaknesses
- customize "next steps"

We have goal week coming up soon. The students will use these scores to set goals and track their progress. You will be informed of goal week so you can ask your student about his/her goals.

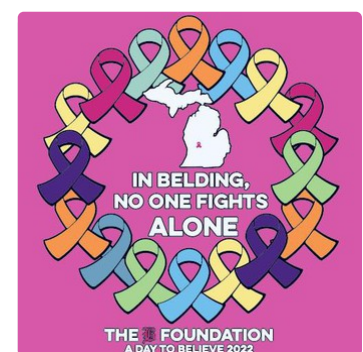

Individual prizes for participating in challenges will be offered as well. More details will come home with your child next week!

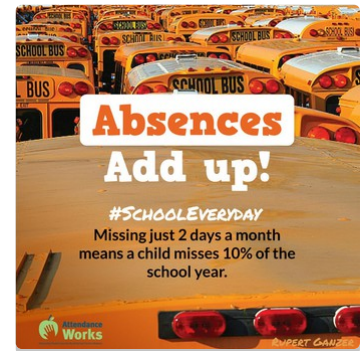

Transportation Changes

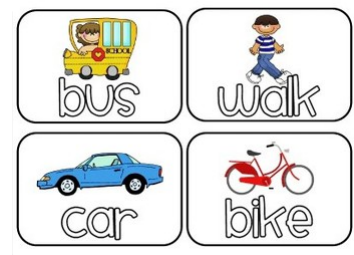
Please call the Woodview office 616-794-4750
