Greetings! It is hard to believe that we are over half-way through January. Our last week has been a challenge with all of the snow and cold. I hope you have survived this brutal dose of Michigan winter! Remember that students are out 3 times a day for recess. Please be sure they are bringing their outside gear and wearing it.

<u>Math:</u> We will soon be done with module 3 in Math (multiplication and division). We will review and then take our test after lesson 24. Each night, students have a homework that should be completed at home. There is also an info sheet at the front of the homework with example problems. Also, if your student is not bringing home their homework, please encourage them to get this extra practice in.

Our next module will be #4 and the focus will be fractions.

<u>Science/Social Studies:</u> We are now working on a sound unit in Science. We completed our first experiment this week. Students were able to build a paper cup telephone and talk with their partner. Ask you student about this process.

Language Arts: Our focus in whole group Wonders is realistic fiction. We also continue reading groups during our Google Classroom time. When students are not in a group, they are completing items assigned in their google classroom. We are using companion books from Wonders. We also do spelling activities, sentences, and a weekly dialogue journal. This journal allows us to practice our writing and get to know one another.

AR: Students will be given AR point goals for 3rd marking period soon. With our unexpected time off this week, we did not get to this. 3rd marking period ends on March 8th. Keep reading and taking tests.
