Greetings from 4th grade. Our Valentine's Day parties will be on February 14th. **Math:** Students took a test on Module 3 last Monday. We started Module 4—Fractions on Tuesday. Each night, students have a homework that should be completed at home. There is also an info sheet at the front of the homework with example problems. Also, if your student is not bringing home their homework, please encourage them to get this extra practice in.

**Science/Social Studies:** We are will be finishing up our Sound unit this week. We will then start a Social Studies unit on the regions of the United States. Students will be labeling each state and capital. We will also be learning key details about each region.

Language Arts: Our focus in whole group Wonders is now biography. We also continue reading groups during our Google Classroom time. When students are not in a group, they are completing items assigned in their google classroom. We are using companion books from Wonders. We also do spelling activities, sentences, and a weekly dialogue journal. This journal allows us to practice our writing and get to know one another.
