

Science: We have completed four lessons in our first unit in Mystery Science—"The Birth of Rocks". We will continue do our final lesson next week that is based on Landslides.

Language Arts: We are in Unit 1 of our Reading/Writing program called "Wonders". This week we started to read stories that answer the question, "How do a person's actions affect others?" We also do a weekly dialogue journal. This journal allows us to practice our writing and get to know one another. We have also started spelling activities, sentences, and grammar practice.
