We are trying a new math program this year from Eureka Math. It is very similar to Engage NY with a few differences. When your child brings home their math homework, you should notice that there is a page that explains the lesson and tells the family how to help their child with their homework.

HOMEWORK

Your child should bring math homework every night except for Fridays and nights that we have a quiz or test. They are also expected to read at home every night for at least 15 minutes. This is how they become better readers... by practicing reading at their level or challenging themselves by reading a little above their level.



WHAT ARE WE DOING IN CLASS??

In Math, we just wrapped up our first module on Place Value and had our first big test. We begin our Multiplication and Division Module on Monday, October 9th!
