Important Reminders:

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What's Happening in 4th Grade! The students have been working hard to get in to routines again after this long break! They have been doing great!

Math: We have just started ended Mission 3 in Math and we have started on to Mission 4. In Mission 4, we are working on constructing lines, angles, and shapes. The students are in the early stages of this unit, but they have been really grasping on to the content. Challenge them at home to show you what a point, line segment, ray, and line are! Please check in with them every night to make sure it is done. That way, they can bring it back the next day and it can be graded! I do remind them of any homework they may have every day, so please be aware. Reminder: They should have their Problem Sets AND Homework sheets in their folder that should be traveling from home to school every day.
