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What's happening in 4th Grade!
The students have been working extra hard this week to master goals in the classroom!

Math: We are at the end of Mission 5 in math! The students have been working hard learning about fractions (how to add and subtract them with alike and unlike numerators and denominators!) Our unit test is coming up fast, so please be reviewing with your child. Please be aware of homework coming home. If the students do not finish in class, they should be taking it home.
